Federal Funding Account Round 2 Data and Public Map Overview

About

The Public Map is a visual tool to identify eligible locations for the second round of the Federal Funding Account grant applications. The California Public Utilities Commission will accept funding applications for projects within the following six counties in Round 2: Calaveras, Contra Costa, Inyo, Monterey, Orange and Trinity.

Map Information

- View map: Federal Funding Account Round 2 Public Map.
- To view the served status of a particular address, use the search tool by clicking on the magnifying glass in the top right.
- Default map layers: Federal Funding Account Locations, Statewide Middle-Mile Broadband Network, County boundaries, Tribal Areas, Federal Funding Account Eligible Counties for Round 2.
