**location\_id** - FCC unique 10-digit ID of the fabric location.

**CB2020** - 15-digit code of the 2020 Census Block assigned to the location.

**Cnty2020** - 5-digit code of the county assigned to the location.

**CountyName** - Name of the county.

**cpuc\_disposition** - Locations lacking access to wireline 25 Mbps downstream and 3 Mbps upstream excluding legacy technology (e.g., Digital Subscriber Line and Cable DOCSIS 2.0 or older) are considered "unserved" while those with wireline broadband service with 25 Mbps / 3 Mbps or faster are considered "served" locations. Uses Federal Communications Commission June 2022 deployment data as input. See [Frequently Asked Questions](#) for more information.

**fcc\_rel** - FCC Fabric release date.

**NOTE: 91 Fabric location records lack disposition because they don't have a result in the cost model. This happens when a location is too far from a road to connect to the network or when it falls outside the state boundaries based on Census 2010.**
