

**Consent Form #1: Information Required from Eligible Applicants or
Representatives of Eligible Applicants**

Instructions

An “eligible applicant” is the customer residing at the location to be served. A “representative” of an eligible applicant, including a broadband service provider, may apply for a line extension on behalf of an eligible applicant or a group of eligible applicants.

Each eligible applicant and representative, if there is one, must submit a separate signed and dated copy of this consent form for each location to be served. If one application covers a group of eligible applicants, a consent form is still required from each household.

If an eligible applicant is not the property owner, the eligible applicant or representative must provide a signed statement from the property owner giving the property owner’s consent for the work to be done, as described in the contract. (See Consent Form #2)
