Local Agency Technical Assistance (LATA)

Local Agency Technical Assistance grants support efforts by California Tribes and local agencies to expand broadband service to unserved and underserved Californians by increasing access to engineering, expert consulting, market analysis, environmental assessments, and other foundational elements of deployment networks.


\$50 million awarded to 106 Projects

The Local Agency Technical Assistance (LATA) was established by the CPUC according to Senate Bill 156 (2021) enabling \$50 million grant program; \$5 million was allocated for tribes. As of June 30, 2023, the LATA funding is fully allocated, and applications are no longer accepted.

- 106 grants for LATA projects awarded since
 October 2022.
- \$44,992,170 to 97 local agencies.
- \$4,992,517 to 9 tribes.
