VIOLATIONS

- (1) Operated as a Charter-Party Carrier after expiration of authority, in violation of Pub. Util. Code Section 5379 **[2 counts]**;
- (2) Operated at an airport without an airport authority and failure to follow airport rules and regulations, in violation of Pub. Util. Code Section 5371.4(b) and G.O. 157-E, Part 3.02 **[2 counts]**.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The above violations are documented in the attached Investigation Report, which consists of the carrier's records and substantiating documents obtained from other sources.

RESPONSE

You are hereby called upon to answer this citation on or before December 11, 2024. By way of such an answer, you may either:

- (1) Pay a fine of \$8,000 pursuant to Pub. Util. Code Section 5378. Submit your check or money order payable to California Public Utilities Commission using the attached *Citation Agreement*. Upon payment, the fine will be deposited in the State Treasury to the credit of the General Fund and the CPUC staff will deem the matter closed, **or**
- (2) Contact the Supervisor below to make payment arrangements, **or**
- (3) Contest this Citation by filing an Appeal. See the attached document "*How to File an Appeal and Instructions for Filing a Notice of Appeal and Certificate of Service for a Citation Appeal.*"

If you fail to respond by December 11, 2024, you will be in default and will have forfeited your right to appeal the Citation. The CPUC may also act through a civil or criminal proceeding to recover any unpaid fine and ensure compliance with applicable statutes and CPUC orders.

INTRODUCTION

On September 27, 2024, I was assigned to investigate the operations and practices of Abdulhakim Amer Radman dba Medry Limo Services (hereinafter referred to as Abdulhakim) because of a San Francisco International Airport (SFO) complaint alleging that Abdulhakim operated after the expiration of authority and no airport authority.

HISTORY OF ENFORCEMENT

Enforcement case records show Abdulhakim has a history of violating the California Public Utilities Commission's (CPUC) rules and regulations, as detailed below.

On August 28, 2023, CPUC's Transportation Enforcement Analyst, Aaron Pete, served Abdulhakim Citation No. T.23-08-002 in the amount of \$5,000 for the following violations [**Attachment 1**]:

- Operated as a charter-party carrier after expiration of authority;
- Advertised as a charter-party carrier without a valid authority;
- Operated at an airport without an airport permit.

VIOLATIONS

I investigated Abdulhakim for the period of August 30, 2024, through September 7, 2024, and found violations of the following provisions of the Public Utilities (Pub. Util.) Code and a CPUC General Order (G.O.):

- **Operated as a Charter-Party Carrier (TCP) after expiration of authority, in violation of Pub. Util. Code Section 5379. [2 counts]**

Pub. Util. Code 5379 states in part that "After the cancellation or revocation of a permit or certificate, or during the period of its suspension, or after the expiration of its permit or certificate, it is unlawful for a charter-party carrier of passengers to conduct any operations as a carrier."

On March 3, 2015, Abdulhakim's operating authority has expired. Abdulhakim's TCP P Permit [**Attachment 2**] shows that his operating authority will expire on March 3, 2015, if the contract is not renewed, and any unlawful operations are subject to fines and penalties as outlined in the Pub. Util. Code.

On August 30, 2024, SFO Ground Transportation Unit (GTU) served Abdulhakim a Notice to Cease and Desist No. [REDACTED] for operating after expiration of authority [Attachment 3].

On September 7, 2024, SFO Ground Transportation Unit (GTU) served Abdulhakim a Notice to Cease and Desist No. [REDACTED] for operating after expiration of authority [Attachment 4].

The Notice to Cease and Desists that SFO GTU served Abdulhakim show two days of operation after expiration of authority **Table 1**.

- **Operated without an airport permit and failed to follow airport rules and regulations, in violation of Pub. Util. Code Section 5371.4(b), 5381 and G.O. 157-E, Part 3.02. [2 counts]**

G.O. 157-E, Part 3.02 states in part that “No carrier shall conduct any operations on the property of or into any airport unless such operations are authorized by both this Commission and the airport authority involved. Consistent failure to comply with safety or traffic rules and regulations of an airport authority may result in suspension or revocation of Commission operating authority.”

On August 30, 2024, SFO Ground Transportation Unit (GTU) served Abdulhakim a Notice to Cease and Desist No. [REDACTED] for operating at SFO without an airport permit [Attachment 3].

On September 7, 2024, SFO Ground Transportation Unit (GTU) served Abdulhakim a Notice to Cease and Desist No. [REDACTED] for operating at SFO without an airport permit [Attachment 4].

The Notice to Cease and Desists that SFO GTU served Abdulhakim, show two days of operation at SFO without an airport permit **Table 1**.

Upon payment, the fine will be deposited in the State Treasury to the credit of the General Fund and the Commission staff will deem the matter closed, **or**
- (2) Contact the Supervisor below to make payment arrangements, **or**
- (3) Contest this Citation by filing an Appeal. See attached document "*How to File an Appeal and Instructions for Filing a Notice of Appeal and Certificate of Service for a Citation Appeal.*"

If you fail to respond by September 18, 2023, you will be in default and will have forfeited your right to appeal the Citation. In addition, your operating authority will be immediately suspended and may be subsequently revoked pursuant to Resolution ALJ-187. The Commission may also act through a civil or criminal proceeding to recover any unpaid fine and ensure compliance with applicable statutes and Commission orders.

TCP P PERMIT

The above-named Carrier, having made written application to the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California for a certificate to operate as a CHARTER-PARTY CARRIER OF PASSENGERS, pursuant to Sections 5351 through 5420 of the Public Utilities Code, is granted this certificate authorizing the transportation of passengers by motor vehicle over the public highways of the State of California as a CHARTER-PARTY CARRIER OF PASSENGERS, as defined in said Code, subject to the following conditions:

1. This permit is issued pursuant to Public Utilities Code Section 5384(b), and is limited to the use of vehicles under 15-passenger seating capacity.
2. No vehicle or vehicles shall be operated by said Carrier unless adequately covered by a public liability and property damage insurance policy or surety bond as required by Public Utilities Code Section 5392.
3. Said Carrier shall comply with all Commission orders, decisions, rules, directions, and requirements governing the operations of said Carrier including General Order Series 115 and 157 and shall remit to the Commission the Transportation Reimbursement Fee required by Public Utilities Code Section 403.
4. All vehicles operated under this permit shall comply with the requirements of the Motor Carrier Safety Section of the California Highway Patrol. No vehicle shall be operated unless it is named in the Carrier's most recent equipment list on file with this Commission. Written amendments to the equipment list shall be filed within ten days of the date the vehicle is put into or pulled out of service.
5. This permit is subject to amendment, modification, suspension or revocation as provided in the Public Utilities Code and in Commission Resolutions PE-498, PE-501, and TL-18336.
6. This permit may not be sold, assigned, leased, or otherwise transferred or encumbered without Commission authorization.
7. This permit does not authorize the Carrier to conduct operations on the property of or into any airport unless such operation is authorized by the airport authority involved.
8. This permit does not authorize round-trip sightseeing tour service.
9. The use of top lights and/or taxi meters in all vehicles operated under this permit is prohibited (D. 82-05-069).
10. **This permit expires 2015-03-03.** It may be renewed every three (3) years upon submission and approval of a renewal application. **This renewal application should be submitted 90-days prior to the expiration date.**
