VIOLATIONS

You are hereby cited as having violated sections of the Public Utilities (Pub. Util.) Code and a General Order (G.O.) as described below. These violations occurred on October 24, 2024, and January 1, 2025.

1. Operated at an airport without an airport permit and failure to follow airport rules and regulations, in violation of Pub. Util. Code Sections 5371.4(b), 5381, and G.O. 157-E, Part 3.02 [**2 counts**]

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The above violations are documented in the attached Investigation Report, which consists of the carrier's records and substantiating documents obtained from other sources.

RESPONSE

You are hereby called upon to answer this citation on or before April 23, 2025. By way of such an answer, you may either:

- (1) Pay a fine of \$4,000 pursuant to Pub. Util. Code Section 5378. Submit your check or money order payable to California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC) using the attached *Citation Agreement*. Upon payment, the fine will be deposited in the State Treasury to the credit of the General Fund and the CPUC staff will deem the matter closed, **or**
- (2) Contact the Supervisor below to make payment arrangements, **or**
- (3) Contest this Citation by filing an Appeal. See the attached document "*How to File an Appeal and Instructions for Filing a Notice of Appeal and Certificate of Service for a Citation Appeal.*"

If you fail to respond by April 23, 2025, you will be in default and will have forfeited your right to appeal the Citation. In addition, your operating authority will be immediately suspended and may be subsequently revoked pursuant to Resolution ALJ-187. The CPUC may also act through a civil or criminal proceeding to recover any unpaid fine and ensure compliance with applicable statutes and CPUC orders.

INTRODUCTION

On January 6, 2025, I was assigned to investigate the operations and practices of Executive Premier Limousine, Inc. (hereinafter referred to as Executive Premier) because of a consumer complaint alleging that Executive Premier operated with a suspended TCP authority and without an active airport permit.

HISTORY OF ENFORCEMENT

Enforcement case records show Executive Premier has a history of violating the California Public Utilities Commission's (CPUC) rules and regulations, as detailed below.

On November 22, 2024, CPUC's Program and Project Supervisor, Eric Hooks, sent Executive Premier an Airport Authority Letter, via email, for operations at San Francisco International Airport (SFO) on October 24, 2024 without a valid airport permit [**Attachment 1**].

VIOLATIONS

I investigated Executive Premier for the period of October 24, 2024, and January 1, 2025, and found violations of the following provisions of the Public Utilities (Pub. Util.) Code and a CPUC General Order (G.O.):

- **Operated at an airport without an airport permit and failure to follow airport rules and regulations, in violation of Pub. Util. Code Sections 5371.4(b), 5381, and G.O. 157-E, Part 3.02. [2 counts]**

G.O. 157-E, Part 3.02 states in part that "No carrier shall conduct any operations on the property of or into any airport unless such operations are authorized by both this Commission and the airport authority involved. Consistent failure to comply with safety or traffic rules and regulations of an airport authority may result in suspension or revocation of Commission operating authority."

On October 24, 2024, the San Francisco Police Department (SFPD) issued Executive Premier Citation # [REDACTED] for operating at the San Francisco International Airport (SFO) without an airport permit [**Attachment 2**]. On January 1, 2025, the SFO Ground Transportation Unit (GTU) issued Executive Premier Citation # [REDACTED] for operating at SFO without an airport permit [**Attachment 3**].

My investigation disclosed that Executive Premier failed to follow airport rules and regulations and conducted two days of operation without an airport permit.

SUBJECT: AIRPORT PERMIT REQUIRED

Dear Sherif Elsayad:

Executive Premier Limousine, Inc. was observed conducting for-hire operations on October 24, 2024, at the San Francisco International Airport (SFO) without an airport permit. A Charter-Party Carrier (TCP) permit or certificate, issued by the California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC) does not authorize operations at any airport property. This notice is to inform Executive Premier Limousine, Inc. that an airport permit is required or a minimum fine of \$1,000 may be issued. Each day of continued violations is a separate and distinct offense. Your action is required immediately.

General Order 157-E, Part 3, Section 3.02, with regards to TCPs, states in part that no carrier shall conduct any operations on the property of or into any airport unless such operations are authorized by both CPUC and the airport authority involved. Failure to comply with safety or traffic rules and regulations of an airport authority may result in suspension or revocation of CPUC operating authority.
