VIOLATIONS

You are hereby cited as having violated sections of the Public Utilities (Pub. Util.) Code and the California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC) General Order (G.O.) as described below. These violations occurred during the period of May 19, 2026.

- (1) Operated at an airport without an airport permit and failed to follow airport rules and regulations in violation of Pub. Util. Code Section 5381 and G.O. 157-E, Part 3.02. **[1 count]**
- (2) Operated as a Charter-Party Carrier (TCP) during suspension of authority, in violation of Pub. Util. Code Section 5379. **[1 count]**

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The above violation is documented in the attached Investigation Report, which consists of the carrier's records and substantiating documents obtained from other sources.

RESPONSE

TEB used the Penalty Assessment Methodology adopted in Resolution M-4846 and considered mitigating and exacerbating factors in setting the fine.

You are hereby called upon to answer this citation on or before August 20, 2026. By way of such an answer, you may either:

- (1) Pay a fine of \$6,000 pursuant to Pub. Util. Code Section 5378. Submit your payment online via TCP Portal (<https://tcpportal.cpuc.ca.gov/s/login/>) using a credit card, ACH or check. Upon payment, the fine will be deposited in the State Treasury to the credit of the General Fund, and the Commission staff will deem the matter closed, **or**
- (2) Contact the Supervisor below to make payment arrangements, **or**
- (3) Contest this Citation by filing an Appeal. See attached document *"How to File an Appeal and Instructions for Filing a Notice of Appeal and Certificate of Service for a Citation Appeal."*

If you fail to respond by August 20, 2026, you will be in default and will have forfeited your right to appeal the Citation. In addition, your operating authority will be immediately suspended and may be subsequently revoked pursuant to Resolution ALJ-187. The Commission may also act through a civil or criminal proceeding to recover any unpaid fine and ensure compliance with applicable statutes and Commission orders.

INTRODUCTION

On June 3, 2026, I was assigned to investigate the operations and practices of Exquisite Transportation Services LLC, doing business as (dba) ETS United (hereinafter referred to as Exquisite Transportation) because of a complaint alleging that Exquisite Transportation operated at San Francisco International Airport (SFO) with a suspended CPUC authority and without an airport permit.

HISTORY OF ENFORCEMENT

Enforcement case records show Exquisite Transportation has a history of violating the California Public Utilities Commission's (CPUC) rules and regulations, as detailed below.

On March 4, 2026, I issued Citation T.2026-02-012 to Exquisite Transportation in the amount of \$4,000 for the following violations **[Attachment 1]**:

- Operated at an airport without an airport permit and failed to follow airport rules and regulations in violation of Pub. Util. Code Section 5381 and G.O. 157-E, Part 3.02. **[2 counts]**;
- Engaged one employee-driver without evidence of Workers' Compensation (WKCP) insurance coverage in effect and on file with the CPUC, in violation of Pub. Util. Code Section 5378.1. **[2 counts]**

VIOLATIONS

I investigated Exquisite Transportation for the period of May 19, 2026, and found violations of the following provisions of the Public Utilities (Pub. Util.) Code and CPUC General Order (G.O.):

- **Operated at an airport without an airport permit and failed to follow airport rules and regulations in violation of Pub. Util. Code Section 5381 and G.O. 157-E, Part 3.02. [1 count]**

G.O. 157-E, Part 3.02 states in part that "No carrier shall conduct any operations on the property of or into any airport unless such operations are authorized by both this Commission and the airport authority involved."

- **Operated as a TCP during suspension of authority in violation of Pub. Util. Code Section 5379. [1 count]**

Pub. Util. Code 5379 states in part that "During the suspension of its permit or certificate, it is unlawful for a charter-party carrier of passengers to conduct any operations as a carrier."

On May 19, 2026, SFO GTU issued Exquisite Transportation Administrative Citation #38578 **[Attachment 2]** for operating without an airport permit, without a TCP number displayed on vehicle with license plate [REDACTED] and soliciting passengers. My investigation disclosed that Exquisite Transportation operated for one day during the suspension of its CPUC authority and one day without an airport permit.

I have read the foregoing and know the contents thereof and I declare under penalty of perjury that the foregoing is true and correct, except as to those matters stated on information and belief, and to those matters, I believe to be true.
