**VIOLATIONS**

You are hereby cited as having violated a section of the Public Utilities (Pub. Util.) Code as described below. This violation occurred during the period of February 14, 2026.

- (1) Operated as a Charter-Party Carrier (TCP) during suspension of authority, in violation of Pub. Util. Code Section 5379. [**1 count**]

## STATEMENT OF FACTS

The above violation is documented in the attached Investigation Report, which consists of the carrier's records and substantiating documents obtained from other sources.

## RESPONSE

TEB used the Penalty Assessment Methodology adopted in Resolution M-4846 and considered mitigating and exacerbating factors in setting the fine.

You are hereby called upon to answer this citation on or before May 26, 2026. By way of such an answer, you may either:

- (1) Pay a fine of \$2,000 pursuant to Pub. Util. Code Section 5378. Submit your check or money order payable to CPUC using the attached *Citation Agreement*. Upon payment, the fine will be deposited in the State Treasury to the credit of the General Fund, and the Commission staff will deem the matter closed, **or**
- (2) Contact the Supervisor below to make payment arrangements, **or**
- (3) Contest this Citation by filing an Appeal. See attached document "*How to File an Appeal and Instructions for Filing a Notice of Appeal and Certificate of Service for a Citation Appeal.*"

If you fail to respond by May 26, 2026, you will be in default and will have forfeited your right to appeal the Citation. In addition, your operating authority will be immediately suspended and may be subsequently revoked pursuant to Resolution ALJ-187. The Commission may also act through a civil or criminal proceeding to recover any unpaid fine and ensure compliance with applicable statutes and Commission orders.

## INTRODUCTION

On February 20, 2026, I was assigned to investigate the operations and practices of New Millennium Limousine LLC (hereinafter referred to as New Millennium), due to a complaint alleging that New Millennium operated at San Francisco International Airport (SFO) while its authority was suspended and used a non-commercial vehicle not listed on its equipment list.

## VIOLATION

I investigated Millennium Limousine for the period of February 14, 2026, in which I discovered a violation of the following provisions of the Public Utilities (Pub. Util.) Code:

- **Operated as a Charter-Party Carrier (TCP) during suspension of authority, in violation of Pub. Util. Code Section 5379. [1 count]**

The California Public Utilities Commission's (CPUC) Transportation Licensing and Analysis Branch (TLAB) records show that a Notice of Voluntary Suspension of Operating Authority was sent to New Millennium on February 3, 2026, approving the request for voluntary suspension for the period of February 3, 2026, to May 31, 2028 [**Attachment 1**].

On February 14, 2026, San Francisco International Airport (SFO) Ground Transportation Unit (GTU), Investigator Ricky San issued New Millennium Citation #129604 [**Attachment 2**] for operating during suspension.

My investigation disclosed that New Millennium operated one (1) day during suspension of its authority.

## DECLARATION

I have read the foregoing and know the contents thereof and I declare under penalty of perjury that the foregoing is true and correct, except as to those matters stated on information and belief, and to those matters, I believe to be true.

Your request to voluntarily suspend the CPUC-issued transportation operating authority (permit or certificate) listed on this letter has been approved.

If not sooner, your period of voluntary suspension will automatically terminate upon expiration of your operating authority on **5/31/2028**.

Placing your operating authority in "Voluntary Suspension" status allows you to pause compliance with certain operating requirements, such as possession of active insurance, without causing your operating authority to become revoked.

**IMPORTANT:** During the period of voluntary suspension, the following actions are still required to avoid becoming revoked. Failing to adhere to conditions (2) and (3) below may result in revocation of your operating authorities at any time.

- 1) To cease operations
- 2) To file quarterly or annual Public Utilities Commission Transportation Reimbursement Account (PUCTRA) reports of gross intrastate operating revenue and to pay any required PUCTRA fees
- 3) To respond to information requests from the Commission

After the cancellation or revocation of a permit or certificate, or during the period of its suspension, or after the expiration of its permit or certificate, it is unlawful for a Transportation Charter-Party carrier (TCP) of passengers to conduct any operations as a carrier. (California Public Utilities Code §§ 5379). Unlawful operations are subject to fines and penalties as set forth in the California Public Utilities Code and may include permanent revocation of your operating authority or being permanently barred from receiving an operating authority.


