VIOLATIONS

You are hereby cited with having violated section(s) of the Public Utilities Code (Pub. Util. Code) and California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC) General Order (G.O.) as described below. This violation occurred on June 25, 2026.

- **Operated as a charter-party carrier without authority in violation of Pub. Util. Code Section 5371 [1 count].**

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The above violations are documented in the attached Investigation Report, which consists of carrier's records and substantiating documents obtained from other sources.

RESPONSE

TEB used the Penalty Assessment Methodology adopted in Resolution M-4846 and considered mitigating and exacerbating factors in setting the fine.

You are hereby called upon to answer this citation on or before July 19, 2026. By way of such answer, you may either:

- (1) Pay a fine of \$1,500 pursuant to Pub. Util. Code Section 5378. Submit your payment online via TCP Portal (<https://tcpportal.cpuc.ca.gov/s/login/>) using a credit card, ACH or check. Upon payment, the fine will be deposited in the State Treasury to the credit of the General Fund, and the Commission staff will deem the matter closed, **or**
- (2) Contact the Supervisor below to make payment arrangements, **or**
- (3) Contest this Citation by filing an Appeal. See attached document *"How to File an Appeal and Instructions for Filing a Notice of Appeal and Certificate of Service for a Citation Appeal."*

If you fail to respond by July 19, 2026 you will be in default and will have forfeited your right to appeal the Citation. In addition, your operating authority will be immediately suspended and may be subsequently revoked pursuant to Resolution ALJ-187. The Commission may also act through a civil or criminal proceeding to recover any unpaid fine and ensure compliance with applicable statutes and Commission orders.

INTRODUCTION

On June 26, 2026, I was assigned to investigate the operations and practices of Shakhbozbek Shomurotov, because Mr. Shomurotov was observed soliciting transportation services in exchange for compensation with a 2023 GMC Yukon. This incident occurred during a joint enforcement operation with the California Highway Patrol (CHP) and the Santa Clara Police Department on June 25, 2026 [Attachment 1].

VIOLATIONS

The investigation of Shakhbozbek Shomurotov found violations of the following provisions of the Public Utilities (Pub. Util.) Code and Commission General Orders (G.O.):

- **Operated as a charter-party carrier without a valid certificate or permit in violation of Public Utilities Code Section 5371 [1 count].**

On June 25, 2026, CHP Officer Hansen Tam (#18053), Officer Richard Robinson (#21499), and Transportation Enforcement Branch (TEB) Analysts, Mingfeng Li and Steve Esguerra, observed Mr. Shomurotov engaging in soliciting activity. Mr. Shomurotov was observed escorting three (3) passengers to a 2023 GMC Yukon bearing California [REDACTED] and displaying TCP 45108 [Attachment 2].

During the enforcement contact, Officer Hansen Tam interviewed the driver, who then stated that he intended to transport three (3) passengers to San Francisco for one hundred sixty dollars (\$160).

A review of TCPortal showed that a vehicle with [REDACTED] displaying TCP 45108 was listed under AK Lux Transportation. Mr. Shomurotov stated that he rented the vehicle from AK Lux Transportation [REDACTED] and confirmed he was not an employee of AK Lux Transportation. Mr. Shomurotov was issued an Inspection Observation Report [Attachment 3].

Based on these observations, CHP impounded the 2023 GMC Yukon bearing California [REDACTED] pursuant to Vehicle Code section 14602.9 [Attachment 4]. The TEB analyst completed a Request to Impound Vehicle form [Attachment 5].

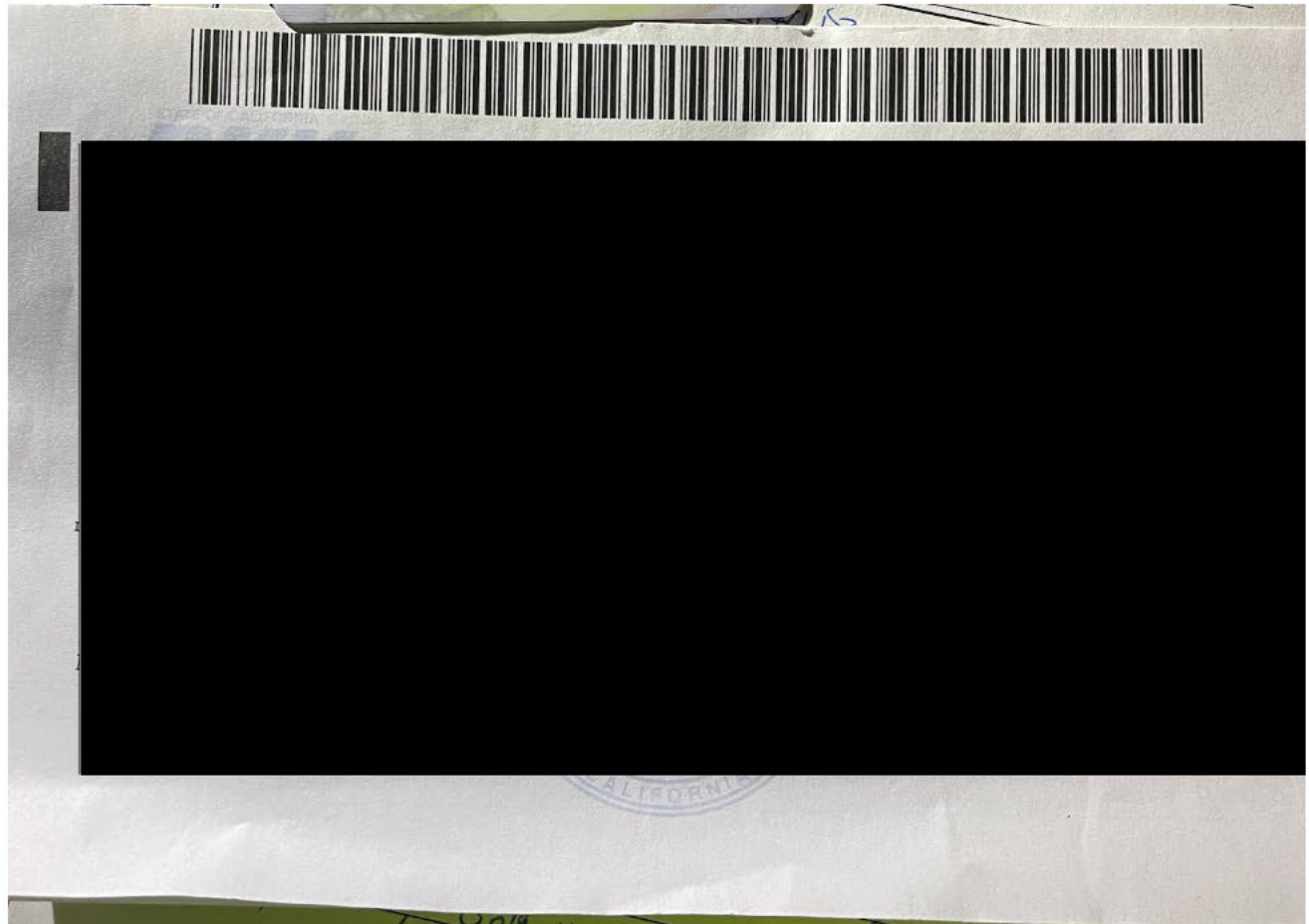
