Summary of FAQs

1. Application Deadline (see prior slides: LAFA Program Timeline 2021)
2. Existing Contracts with Access Providers
 - Competitive process
3. Multi-Year Contracts
 - Program allocates funding annually
4. Board Resolution Signatures
 - Board Chair is required to sign
5. Statewide Fund Administrator
 - Will serve where there are no LAFAs and will allocate that county's available funds to SAFA
6. Unused Funds
 - Will be carried over for obligation in the next funding cycle, prioritizing LAFA then to Statewide if no LAFA is interested
7. Subsidize fares
 - Qualifying expense that's reasonable, improves WAV service, Appendix A in D.20-03-007
8. Eligible Access Providers (Defined in Track 3 D.21-03-005)
 - Access Providers can be TCPs
 - Access Providers aren't just TNCs
