**Subject: Supplemental Advice Letter - Data Response for Building Decarbonization  
OIR for D.23-12-037**

**Purpose**

Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E) submits this Supplemental Tier 1 Advice Letter in its entirety for Advice Letter 4905-G/7255-E, submitted May 1, 2024. The purpose of this Supplemental Advice letter is to update and correct the requested information pursuant to Ordering Paragraph (OP) 8 and OP8a of California Public Utilities Commission (Commission or CPUC) Decision (D.) 23-12-037, which orders PG&E to report on the electric line extension expenditures for the previous calendar year. These expenditures are broken down by customer class for mixed-fuel new construction, all-electric new construction, and retrofits to existing service locations.

In the attached spreadsheet, PG&E provides electric line extension expenditures for the calendar year (i.e., January 1, 2023, through December 31, 2023) for all-electric new construction, and upgrades to existing facilities, including: (1) total electric line extension requests from applicant builders; (2) total electric line extension estimated costs to the builder, as determined by the IOU (both refundable and non-refundable amounts); and (3) total subsidies (i.e., allowances, refunds, and discounts) broken down by exempted and non-exempted projects, disaggregated by month.

**Background**

D.23-12-037 eliminates electric line extension subsidies for all mixed-fuel new construction (building projects that use gas and/or propane in addition to electricity) effective July 1, 2024. D.23-12-037 furthers the Commission's policy goal to adopt policies aimed at reducing greenhouse gas emissions associated with energy use in buildings while also furthering the State of California's goals of reducing economy wide greenhouse gas emissions to 40 percent below 1990 levels by 2030 and achieving carbon neutrality by 2045 or sooner.

Since the issuance of D.23-12-037, Pacific Gas & Electric, Southern California Edison, and San Diego Gas and Electric have consulted with Energy Division staff to develop the content and

format for reporting on electric line extension expenditures, as required by the decision. The attached Excel file table reflects the agreed upon reporting format and content. If any party wishes to receive a previous report, please email PG&E.

The filing would not increase any current rate or charge, cause the withdrawal of service, or conflict with any rate schedule or rule.

### **Protests**
