



Webinar: SB 1221 Neighborhood Decarbonization Pilots

Program Overview, Gas Rulemaking Coordination, and Opportunities for Local Government Participation

To advance California's building decarbonization and climate goals, the California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC) is implementing Senate Bill 1221 (SB 1221), which establishes voluntary neighborhood decarbonization pilots as part of the Commission's long-term gas planning rulemaking, R.24-09-012.

This informational webinar is designed for local governments and community partners to better understand the SB 1221 implementation process and opportunities for community engagement. Staff from the CPUC's Energy Division will provide an overview of the SB 1221 framework, how pilot neighborhoods may be identified, and how the pilot program connects to gas infrastructure planning and replacement activities.

The presentation will also highlight opportunities for local government participation, coordination, and engagement as the CPUC moves forward with implementation. There will be a moderated Q&A session to allow participants to ask questions and share perspectives.
