PURPOSE

In accordance with Public Utilities Code (PUC) Section 591,¹ PacifiCorp, d/b/a Pacific Power (PacifiCorp), submits this supplement to its information-only Advice Letter (AL) 651-E its 2020 Risk Spending Accountability Report (Report). The updated Report is provided as Exhibit A.

BACKGROUND & DISCUSSION

On June 30, 2021, PacifiCorp submitted Advice Letter 651-E, PacifiCorp's 2020 Risk Spending Accountability Report in accordance with the California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC) issued Decision (D.) 19-04-020. The company submits this supplemental filing to correct an error in calculation that was identified following the June 30, 2021 submission.

This updated Risk Spend Accountability Report reflects a correcting entry related to the overstatement of FERC 593 in 2018 and 2019 which was made in September 2020.² The result of the adjustment to FERC 593 is an increase of \$3.1m to 2020 actuals for Distribution expense. The correction, as reflected in the updated RSAR resulted in a distribution expense percentage difference of 8% instead of 29.4% as reported in the June 30, 2021 filing.

PROTESTS

PacifiCorp respectfully requests that the Commission not extend the protest period for this filing and that the protest date of July 20, 2021 remain in place. Anyone wishing to protest this
