The Clean Energy Access (Phase 2) – LA County TECH Grant Application Webinar Purpose, Process, and Q&A

Are you a California 501(c)(3) organization looking to support your community with clean energy solutions? Join our webinar to learn how the TECH Clean California Initiative can help with building decarbonization, healthy homes, electrification technologies, and addressing health-related impacts of clean energy.

The CEA-LAT Grant provides funding opportunities for community-based organizations (CBOs) in Los Angeles County to support outreach and education related to the TECH Initiative. Organizations can apply for awards of up to **\$200,000** to implement activities such as community outreach, staff training, impact evaluation, and implementer coordination.

Priority will be given to projects serving the Aliso Canyon Disaster Area and the San Fernando Valley, and only California tax-exempt 501(c)(3) organizations are eligible to apply.

This webinar will provide valuable details on the grant purpose, eligibility requirements, and application process. Attendees will gain insight into how their organizations can leverage this funding to expand community engagement in clean energy solutions.
