Summary: Southern California Edison Company (SCE) submits this report because SCE is currently facing litigation from a limited number of parties in the Palisades Fire litigation, alleging that SCE overhead electrical facilities impacted by the fire caused damage or obstructed evacuations and firefighting efforts. Plaintiffs do not allege that SCE facilities were involved in the ignition or that SCE is a cause of the Palisades Fire, which erupted

outside SCE?s service territory on January 7, 2025. In fact, authorities announced today that the Palisades Fire was the result of arson. According to Cal Fire, the Palisades Fire burned 23,448 acres, resulted in 12 civilian fatalities, destroyed 6,837 structures, damaged 973 structures, and was fully contained by January 31, 2025. The incident received significant media attention and caused property damage exceeding \$200,000.
