At 1357 hours, the Kern County Fire Department reported the ?Dogs Fire? in the vicinity of Famoso Road and Mt Poso Conservation Plant Road, Bakersfield of Kern County, a non-HFTD. As of June 13, 2025, at 2130 hours, the fire

was recorded at 4,407 acres and at 5% containment. PG&E is aware that the Kern County Fire Department collected PG&E equipment and is currently investigating the incident.
