On behalf of the Safety and Enforcement Division (SED) of the California Public Utilities Commission, Paul Penney and Kai Cheung conducted a General Order 112-F inspection of Pacific Gas & Electric Company's (PG&E) Transmission Integrity Management Program (TIMP) July 18-22, 2022, and October 20, 2022. The inspection included a review of procedures and records related to the TIMP Inspection Assistant (IA) question set, which was focused on Direct Assessments around the Milpitas Terminal.

SED found no violations or concerns and considers this inspection closed. PG&E is not required to provide a response.
