SUBJECT: General Order (GO) 112-F Gas Inspection of West Coast Gas Company

Dear Mr. Williams:

The Safety and Enforcement Division (SED) of the California Public Utilities Commission conducted an inspection of West Coast Gas Company (WCG) on May 08 through May 12, 2023. During the inspection, SED performed a comprehensive review of the maintenance and operations records for the period of January 1, 2019 through December 31, 2022, and the Operations and Maintenance Plan (O&M). SED also performed a field inspection of a representative sample of WCG facilities in the Mather Field area. SED staff also reviewed WCG's Operator Qualification records, which included field observation of WCG personnel performing covered tasks.

SED's staff did not identify any probable violations of GO 112-F, Reference Title 49 Code of Federal Regulations (CFR), Part 192, and considers this inspection closed.
