**Subject: General Order (G.O.) 112-F Compliance Audit of Southern California Gas Company's and San Diego Gas and Electric Company's Pipeline Construction and Material Traceability Program**

Dear Mr. Schwecke:

The Safety and Enforcement Division (SED) of the California Public Utilities Commission conducted a G.O. 112-F audit of Southern California Gas Company's and San Diego Gas and Electric Company's (Sempra) Pipeline Construction and Material Traceability (C&MT) Program on November 12 thru 15 and November 18 thru 22, 2024. SED staff reviewed Sempra's written pipeline construction procedures and pipeline project documentation pursuant to G.O. 112-F, Reference Title 49, Code of Federal Regulations (CFR), Part 192. The audit review period included Sempra's pipeline projects that were closed out during calendar years 2018-2023.

SED staff did not find probable violations or areas of concern. Also, consider this C&MT audit letter an official closure of this audit.
