The Safety and Enforcement Division (SED) of the California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC) reviewed Pacific Gas and Electric Company's (PG&E) requests for an extension of reassessment interval for Line 109 in San Mateo County and Line 300A in Santa Clara County in two letters both dated September 30, 2021 (via email dated October 1, 2021).

After further review and analysis, SED hereby denies PG&E's requests in obtaining waivers from the CPUC pursuant to General Order 112-F, Section 101.3 regarding the two waiver requests. SED believes PG&E should report these violations as self-identified non-compliance notifications pursuant to CPUC Decision 18-05-023.

SED notified PHMSA of its decision to deny PG&E's extension requests. PHMSA responded with no comments or objections.
