



Introduction

In compliance with the California Public Utilities Commission General Order (G.O.) 165, Liberty Utilities (CalPeco Electric) LLC ("Liberty") submits its annual G.O. 165 Compliance Maintenance Program Report.

The Compliance Maintenance Program at Liberty is administered by the electric operations group. The required inspections are performed by Liberty inspectors in accordance with G.O. 165 requirements, and any necessary follow-up maintenance work to correct deficiencies is completed by line crews.

This report contains the results of Liberty's inspection, patrol, and maintenance of electric distribution facilities covering the period from January 1, 2025 through December 31, 2025.

Section 1 – Detailed Inspections:

In 2025, Liberty performed detailed circuit inspections of its distribution system encompassing 275.2 miles of overhead circuits and 92.85 miles of underground circuits in accordance with the requirements of G.O. 165.

- A. Outstanding Inspections: 2.2 miles of underground circuits remained outstanding in 2025 due to resource re-allocation for the storm season and the inspection compliance targets were exceeded for 2025. These miles are scheduled for inspection in 2026.

Section 2 – Patrols:

In 2025, Liberty patrolled all its overhead circuits in accordance with the requirements of G.O. 165 for a total of 585.7 miles.

- A. Outstanding Patrols:

None.

Definitions of Units Reported:

- Patrol units: line miles of overhead line inspected.
- Overhead and underground detailed inspections: units are Line miles. Liberty complies with timelines for overhead and the more stringent underground (where submersible equipment is involved) schedules.
- Wood pole intrusive units: Number of poles inspected.
