Subject: Authorized Balancing Account Outstanding Balances for December 2025 - REVISED

Dear Ms. Rocha:

Per Bruce DeBerry's letter dated June 16, 2014, and your January 16, 2015 email, San Gabriel Valley Water Company provides its REVISED December 31, 2025 balancing account balances below. This REVISED report reflects the final December 31, 2025 balances for several accounts that were not yet available at the time San Gabriel filed its original report on February 13.

Additionally, San Gabriel identifies each balancing account consistent with the following criteria:

(1) Balancing accounts with a quarter-end balance with more than a 10-percent differential from the balancing account's authorized revenue amount.

RESPONSE: San Gabriel interprets "authorized revenue amount" to be the most recent balance reviewed by Water Division in an advice letter or the balance reviewed by the Commission's Public Advocates Office in San Gabriel's 2025 general rate case A.25-01-001, (whichever is more recent). The following table lists the accounts with a quarter-end balance with more than a 10% differential from the "authorized revenue amount." The table also shows the account balance as a percentage of current authorized revenues in the division.

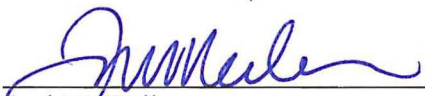

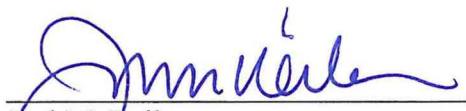
